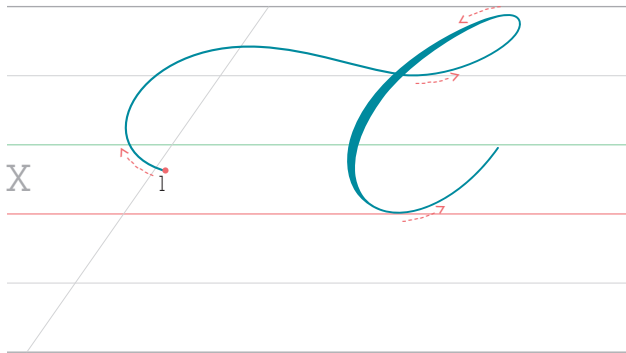




UPPERCASE C



WELCOME TO IRIS SCRIPT!

Inspired by Copperplate, Iris Script is a modern calligraphy that is perfect for beginner and veteran calligraphers, alike, looking to set aside classic precision in favor of a modern, romantic style.

TOOLS

To begin, you'll need a standard calligraphy dip pen (brush pen or soft lead pencil will work, too), ink (sumi or India ink), paper (HP Premium 32lb), and a printer.

PRACTICE
